

Convention No. 120: Hygiene (Commerce and Offices), 1964
Direct request 2002/73

Italy (ratification: 1971)

The Committee takes note of the comprehensive report supplied by the Government in which the latter mainly referred to Legislative Decree No. 626 of 19 September 1994 whose provisions give effect to the Convention.

The Committee further takes note of the observations made by the General Confederation of Industry (CONFINDUSTRIA) on the application of the Convention, which were communicated with the Government's report. In their comments, CONFINDUSTRIA acknowledged that the provisions of the Convention were applied through the provisions of Legislative Decree No. 626 of 19 September 1994 containing the general standards on hygiene at work. CONFINDUSTRIA further indicated that all legislative texts adopted relating to safety and health have been framed by consultations with the organizations of workers and employers concerned, in conformity with *Article 5 of the Convention*.

The Committee, taking due note of the Government's report and the comments formulated by CONFINDUSTRIA, invites the Government to continue to provide information, particularly on the manner in which the Convention is applied in practice in the country, as requested under *Part IV of the report form*.
