

Medical Examination of Young Persons (Sea) Convention, 1921 (No. 16)

Direct request 2005/76

Italy (ratification: 1924)

The Committee notes the Government's response to its previous direct request and that the competent authorities have launched a procedure revising the provisions on medical examination of young persons.

Article 3 of the Convention. Period of validity. The Committee notes in particular the medical certificate which is presently valid for a period of two years from the date of issue. It expresses its hope that the revision process will establish an obligation that young persons should undergo an annual medical examination. The Committee requests the Government to keep it informed on the revision process and to provide the relevant legislative texts, once adopted.
