

Convention No. 16: Medical Examination of Young Persons (Sea), 1921
Direct request 2001/72

Italy (ratification: 1924)

Articles 2 and 3 of the Convention. The Committee notes the information supplied by the Government in its report and particularly Legislative Decree No. 345 of 4 August 1999 transposing Community Directive 94/33/CE on the protection of young people at work. It notes that section 4(3) of the Legislative Decree excludes the legislative and regulatory provisions on health monitoring in regard to young people employed on vessels. The Committee therefore requests the Government to indicate whether Legislative Decree No. 626 of 19 September 1994, section 9, providing an annual medical examination resulting in a medical certificate for young persons between the ages of 15 and 18 years is still in force. If not, the Government is requested to indicate the provisions of national legislation or regulations giving effect to these Articles of the Convention.
