Article 6(1)(c). Identification and supervision of persons under 18 years of age employed on account of an employer or on their own account in streets or places to which the public have access.

Following its previous comments, the Committee notes the Government's statement that there are no legal provisions which provide for the identification and supervision of minors engaged on account of an employer or on their own account in employment carried out in streets and places where public have access. The Committee reminds the Government that according to $Article\ 6(1)(c)$ of the Convention measures of identification and supervision have to be adopted to ensure the application of the provisions related to night work to persons under 18 years of age engaged, on account of an employer or on their own account, in employment or occupations carried on in the streets or in places to which the public have.

The Committee accordingly requests the Government to take the necessary measures in the very near future to ensure identification and supervision of children engaged, on account of an employer or on their own account in employment carried out in streets or in places to which the public have access, in accordance with Article 6(1)(c) of the Convention.

Part V of the report form. Application of the Convention in practice. The Committee notes the Government's information that in 2010, a total of 1,651 children have been found working in contravention of the labour laws, of which 292 violations concerned working hours.
