Following the implementation of the National Information System on unaccompanied minors (SIM), in accordance with article 9 of Italian Law n. 47 of 7 April 2017, a database containing relevant information on unaccompanied minors (UAMs) is currently available.

Sicily is the region with the highest presence rate of UAMs- 21.6% of the total; followed by Lombardy and Emilia-Romagna, respectively with 13.4% and 8.4% of the total.
