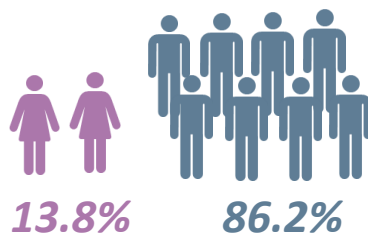

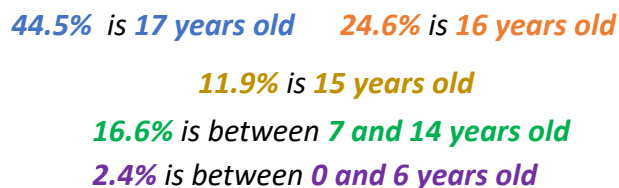
HOW MANY ARE THEY?

As of 30 April 2023, **20,681** UAMs are located in Italy

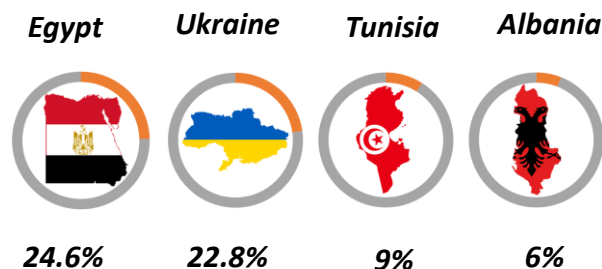
WHAT IS THEIR GENDER?

Sicily is the region with the **highest presence rate** of UAMs- **21.6%** of the total; followed by **Lombardy** and **Emilia-Romagna**, respectively with **13.4%** and **8.4%** of the total.

MONTHLY QUOTA OF NEW ARRIVALS

During the month of April 2023, **2,046** UAMs entered Italian territory

32,3% from **Egypt**
12,1% from **Tunisia**
10,9% from **Guinea**
7,6% from **Ivory Coast**

Notably, UAMs' sea arrivals during April 2023 represent about 75% of all the minors that were reported entering Italian territory.
