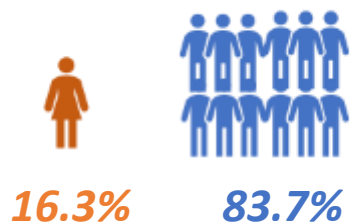

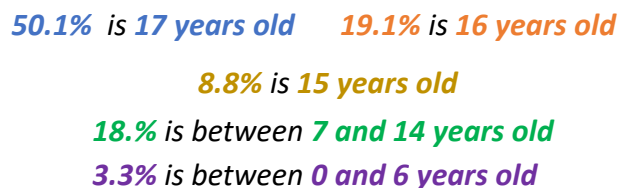
HOW MANY ARE THEY?

As of 30 April 2022, **14,025** UAMs are located in Italy

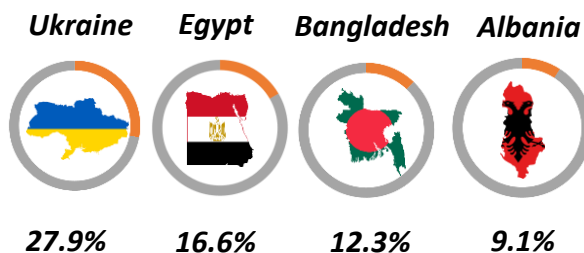
WHAT IS THEIR GENDER?



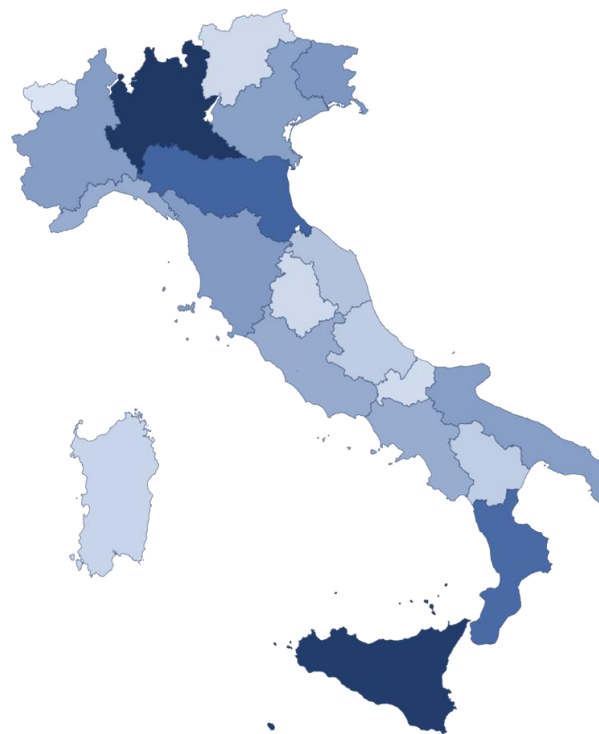
WHAT IS THEIR AGE?

Lombardy is the region with the **highest presence rate** of UAMs- **19.6%** of the total; followed by **Sicily** and **Emilia-Romagna**, respectively with **18%** and **8.8%** of the total.

MONTHLY QUOTA OF NEW ARRIVALS

During the month of April 2022, **1.897** UAMs entered Italian territory

70.2% from **Ukraine**
8.9% from **Egypt**
3.7% from **Afghanistan**
3.2% from **Kosovo**

HOW DID THEY ARRIVE?

Notably, UAMs' sea arrivals during April 2022 represent about 14.3% of all the minors that were reported entering Italian territory.
