On a monthly basis, specific reports providing statistics regarding UAMs are published here.

WHERE ARE THEY LOCATED?



Lombardy is the region with the **highest** presence rate of UAMs- 19.6% of the total; followed by **Sicily** and Emilia-Romagna, respectively with 18% and 8.8% of the total.
