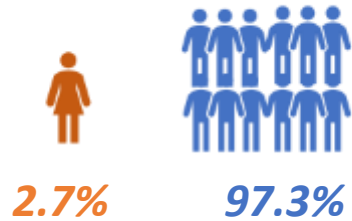

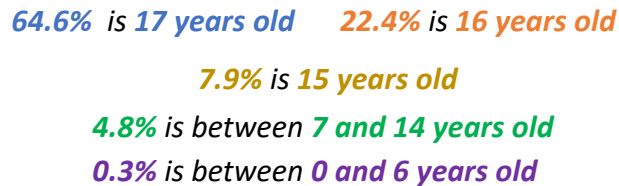
HOW MANY ARE THEY?

As of 01 January 2022, **11,542** UAMs are located in Italy

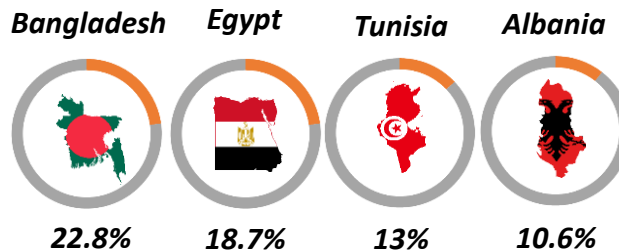
WHAT IS THEIR GENDER?

Sicily is the region with the **highest presence rate** of UAMs- **27.7%** of the total; followed by **Calabria** and **Lombardy**, respectively with **11.1%** and **10.6%** of the total.

MONTHLY QUOTA OF NEW ARRIVALS

During the month of January 2021, **724 UAMs** entered Italian territory

- 21%** from **Egypt**
- 13%** from **Bangladesh**
- 9.7%** from **Albania**
- 7.3%** from **Tunisia**

HOW DID THEY ARRIVE?

Found on territory by Italian authorities sea arrivals



Notably, UAMs' sea arrivals during January 2021 represent about **49.6%** of all the minors that were reported entering Italian territory.
