Following the implementation of the National Information System on unaccompanied minors (SIM), in accordance with article 9 of Italian Law n. 47 of 7 April 2017, a database containing relevant information on unaccompanied minors (UAMs) is currently available.

On a monthly basis, specific reports providing statistics regarding UAMs are published here.

As of 31 January 2023, <u>19.333</u> UAMs are located in Italy

WHERE ARE THEY LOCATED?



Sicily is the region with the highest presence rate of UAMs- 19.1% of the total; followed by Lombardy and Emilia-Romagna, respectively with 14.6% and 9.2% of the total.

During the month of January 2023, 1.188 UAMs entered Italian territory
