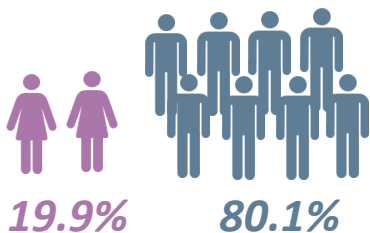

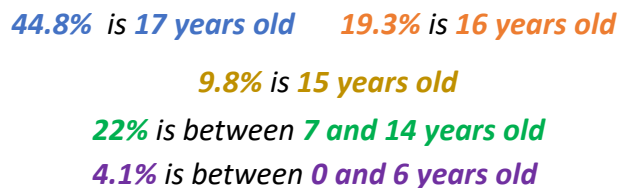
**HOW MANY ARE THEY?**

As of 30 June 2022, **15,595** UAMs are located in Italy

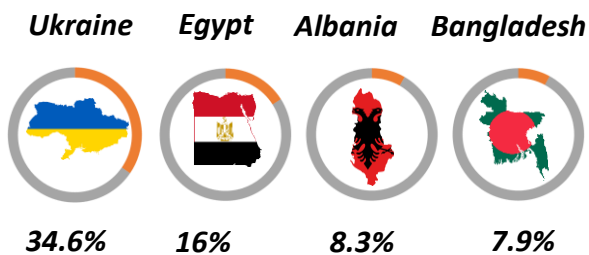
**WHAT IS THEIR GENDER?**



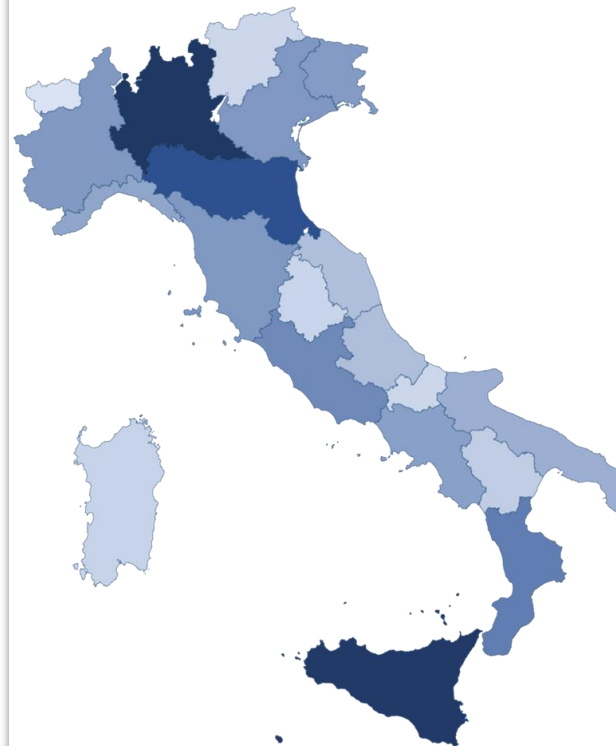
**WHAT IS THEIR AGE?**

**Lombardy** is the region with the **highest presence rate** of UAMs- **18.3%** of the total; followed by **Sicily** and **Emilia-Romagna**, respectively with **17.6%** and **10.5%** of the total.

**MONTHLY QUOTA OF NEW ARRIVALS**

During the month of June 2022, **1,800** UAMs entered Italian territory

- 23.4% from **Ukraine**
- 22.% from **Egypt**
- 13.3% from **Tunisia**
- 7.4% from **Pakistan**

Notably, UAMs' sea arrivals during June 2022 represent about 46.4% of all the minors that were reported entering Italian territory.
