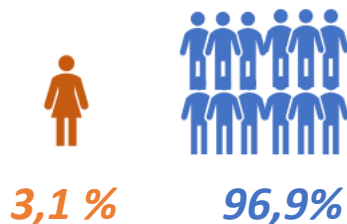


Following the implementation of the National Information System on unaccompanied minors (SIM), in accordance with article 9 of Italian Law n. 47 of 7 April 2017, a database containing relevant information on unaccompanied minors (UAMs) is currently available. As of 31 June 2021, **8382** UAMs are located in Italy

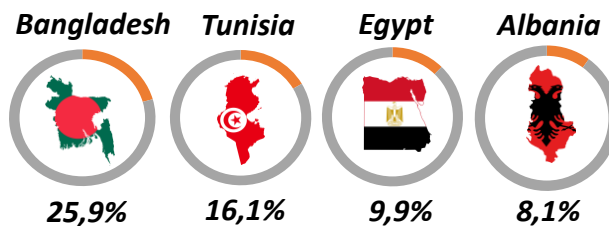
**WHAT IS THEIR GENDER?**

**Sicily** is the region with the **highest presence rate** of UAMs- **33,3%** of the total; followed by **Puglia** and **Friuli-Venezia Giulia**, respectively with **11%** and **10%** of the total.

**MONTHLY QUOTA OF NEW ARRIVALS**

During the month of May, **1175 UAMs** entered Italian territory

**26,4%** from **Bangladesh**  
**24,9%** from **Tunisia**  
**11,7%** from **Egypt**  
**5,8%** from **Pakistan**

Notably, UAMs' sea arrivals during July 2021 represent about 60% of all the minors that were reported entering Italian territory.
