

WHERE ARE THEY LOCATED?



Lombardy is the region with the highest presence rate of UAMs- 19.8% of the total; followed by Sicily and Emilia-Romagna, respectively with 15.8% and 10.2% of the total.

During the month of May 2022, 1,874 UAMs entered Italian territory
