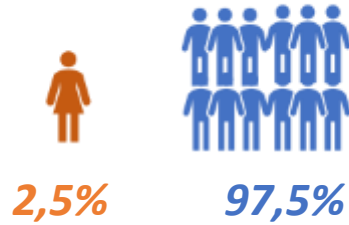


Following the implementation of the National Information System on unaccompanied minors (SIM), in accordance with article 9 of Italian Law n. 47 of 7 April 2017, a database containing relevant information on unaccompanied minors (UAMs) is currently available. As of 31 October 2021, **10.317** UAMs are located in Italy

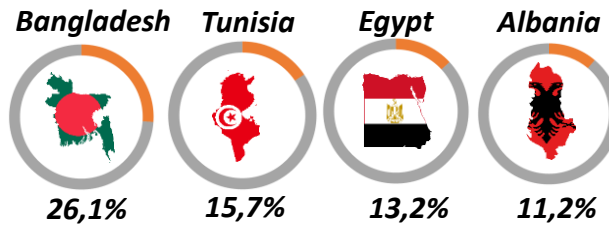

Sicily is the region with the **highest presence rate** of UAMs- **29,4%** of the total; followed by **Lombardy** and **Friuli-Venezia Giulia**, respectively with **10,3%** and **9,9%** of the total.

MONTHLY QUOTA OF NEW ARRIVALS

During the month of October 2021, **1.0000** UAMs entered Italian territory

30.2% from **Egypt**
17,2% from **Bangladesh**
13,1% from **Albania**
11,7% from **Tunisia**

HOW DID THEY ARRIVE?

Found on territory by Italian authorities sea arrivals



Notably, UAMs' sea arrivals during October 2021 represent about 47,2% of all the minors that were reported entering Italian territory.
