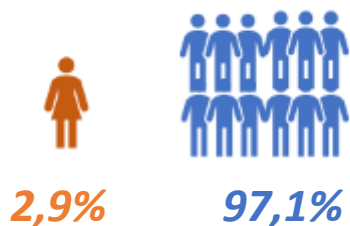


Following the implementation of the National Information System on unaccompanied minors (SIM), in accordance with article 9 of Italian Law n. 47 of 7 April 2017, a database containing relevant information on unaccompanied minors (UAMs) is currently available. As of 30 September 2021, **9,661** UAMs are located in Italy

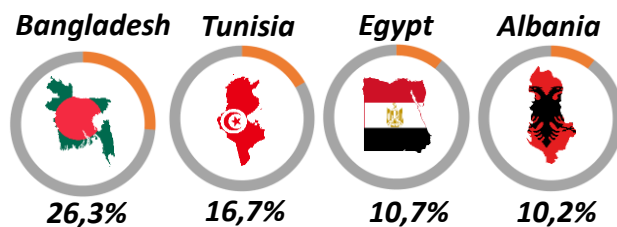

**Sicily** is the region with the **highest presence rate** of UAMs- **32,5%** of the total; followed by **Friuli-Venezia Giulia** and **Lombardy**, respectively with **10,3%** and **10,2%** of the total.

**MONTHLY QUOTA OF NEW ARRIVALS**

During the month of September 2021, **1.005** UAMs entered Italian territory

**24,8%** from **Albania**  
**22,7%** from **Bangladesh**  
**14,8%** from **Egypt**  
**10,1%** from **Tunisia**

Notably, UAMs' sea arrivals during September 2021 represent about 32,4% of all the minors that were reported entering Italian territory.
